# Arrival and travel connections

Arrival and Departure:

The teams are advised to fly to Astana, from where the Event organizers will organize bus transport to the city of the Shchuchinsk and event centre. Shchuchinsk is located 245 km north of Astana.

Teams will be transported on buses from Astana airport to Event

Centre/accommodation in sanatorium «Discovery». Bus transport to Astana airport after the event can be ordered as well.

Fee for bus transport Astana airport – Shchuchinsk – Astana airport is 85\$.

Need for the named bus transport shall be reported to organizer in preliminary entry and paid together with entry fee and accommodation.

### **Classes and participation restrictions**

AsOC

Competition classes are M20, W20, M21 and W21

Competitors representing member Federations of the IOF, defined by the International Olympic Committee as belonging to the Asian continent, can compete in AsOC.

Competitors representing other member Federations of the IOF can participate in AsOC but will not be eligible for Asian titles, medals or diplomas.

In the individual competitions, Federations may enter up to 10 women and up to 10 men in classes W21 and M21 and up to 6 women and up to 6 men in classes W20 and M20.

In the relay competitions, a federation may enter maximum of 2 teams in each gender category and class, but only the better-placed team will be counted in the prize list.

In the Sprint Relay, each Federation may enter 2 teams consisting of 4 team members of whom at least two must be women. Only the better-placed team will be counted in the prize list.

In the relays incomplete teams and teams with runners from more than one Federation are not allowed. Under no circumstances may persons other than entered competitors participate in the competition.

There is no limit on the number of officials.


### Asia Open (AO)

Multiday event Asia Open is open for orienteers from all over the world Competition classes are MW 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 21A, 21B\*, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70.

Classes MW 35-70 will be opened when there are 4 entrants as minimum. The organizer reserves the right to bring together classes with less than 4 entrants. Federations may enter an unlimited number of participants and team officials.

\* - "B" means shorter and technically easier courses compared to "A"-courses

### Embargoed area

Embargoed area is part of the State national nature park Burabay as shown on the map below. The indicated area is embargoed for trainings according to chapter 14 in "Competition rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events 2014" until September 22 2014.



### **Punching system**

SPORTident (SI) punching system will be used. SI-card numbers have to be indicated in final entry. If participants don't have their own SI-cards, these can be rented by the organizer (2 \$/day). Timing system includes use of electronic start gate (in sprint) and light beam on finish lines. All SPORTident equipment will be demonstrated at the Model Event on September 15.

If IOF will during 2014 approve use of touch-free SPORTident equipment at the event, all participants will get appropriate SI-cards from the organizer.

#### Terrain

Competition terrains are part of State national nature park Burabay. Absolute heights in the national park are between 300 and 950 m. Height differences in competition areas are up to 75 m. Slopes in the terrain are of different steepness – from very flat to very steep. There are lot of contour features, various rocky formations and stones on the slopes. Approximately 90% of the terrain is forest with relatively dense network of roads and paths. The forest is predominately pine forest with good sight and no undergrowth. Some birch forest occurs. Roads and paths are well runnable. (*Previous maps of competition terrains and some photos from the terrains are available as appendix to the Bulletin.*)

### Climate

Typical temperature range in middle of September is + 15°C to + 25°C with great differences between night and day; some rains may occur.

### Entry fee and payment:

Entry fee is 40\$ per individual race, 110\$ per relay team and 75\$ per mixed sprint relay team. Accreditation fee for non-competitors is 35 \$ Banquet 40\$ Latest date for payment of entry fees is August 4, 2014.

### Deadlines and address for entries:

### AOC

Preliminary entries giving the number of competitors of each gender, the number of relay teams, the number of team officials and the team manager's name, address, e-mail address and phone/fax should reach the organizer no later than **June 30**, **2014**.

Final entries giving each competitor's name and gender and the names of the team officials shall reach the organiser no later than **September 5, 2014.** 

#### **Open groups (AO)**

Preliminary entries giving the number of competitors of each gender, the number of relay teams, the number of team officials and the team manager's name, address, e-mail address and phone/fax should reach the organizer no later than **June 30**, **2014**.

Final entries giving each competitor's name and gender and the names of the team officials shall reach the organiser no later than **September 5, 2014.** 

All entries have to be sent on official entry forms to Kazakhstan Orienteering Federation by e-mail: asia.kaz-2014@mail.ru.

#### Transport during the event:

Participants are allowed to use their own transport for transfers from accommodation to competitions and model event. Model event and two competitions will be held in immediate neighbourhood of Event centre - Sanatorium

Discovery. There is approximately 25-30 minutes drive to competition centre of two other competitions.

The organizer will provide bus transportation from the event centre/official accommodation to the competition venues and model event.

### Cost for such transport is 70\$ for all competitions.

Transport from official accommodation to opening ceremony will be organised by AOC organizer and is included in start fee.

### Accommodation and catering

All participants will be accommodated in the sanatoriums «Discovery» and «Zelenyi Bor» and sports camp "Zhakshy". The sanatoriums offer only accommodation in package with catering (4 meals a day). <u>Prices for accommodation + 4 meals a day</u>.

Cost includes: accommodation, food (4 meals a day), swimming pool and athletic gym. Check in - check out 12.00 (noon) Prices for accommodation and catering in sanatorium «Zelenyi Bor» and sports camp "Zhakshy" will be announced on event's website before 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2014.

Latest date for payment for accommodation and catering is August 10, 2014.Accommodation and catering costs should be payed together with entry fees to the same bank account (see above).

A banquet will be arranged in the Event centre on September 21 after the closing ceremony.

Banquet cost is 40\$/person to be paid together with accommodation and catering costs.


### Insurance


